Purpose: To inform the Agreement States of the availability of the National Academy of Sciences (NAS) Report "Radiation Source Use and Replacement".

Discussion: The Energy Policy Act of 2005 (Public Law 109-58), Section 651(d), directed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to arrange for the NAS to conduct a study on existing uses of radiation sources and their possible replacement with alternatives.
